Unsellable books left for processing (unlisted ePack components, wrong editions, unlisted books, workbooks with writing in them or books in very poor condition or with offensive drawings) will not be returned to you. No receipts are issued, but this form can be consulted at the shop. Take a photo / copy of this form for your records.

Donations of books or uniforms can be deposited in the marked collection bin at the school office.

Books are graded as follows:

Excellent: As good as new, sell for approx. 75% of new

price

Good: The broadest category, sell for approx. 50% of

new price

Poor: Torn or missing cover or pages, stains,

drawings, 5 or more pages with permanent marks (ink or highlighter, etc.) sell for approx.

25% of new price.

Poor quality books are regarded as donations - you will not be paid for them.

Unsold or overstocked books may be discounted during the year, this will reduce your payment.

You will receive 70% of the selling price of good and excellent quality books **after they sell**. Payments are processed in Term 1 and Term 4. The remaining 30%, plus profits from selling donated or poor-quality goods, goes to the work of the School Chaplain.
